- Applicants must be currently entered in a Pierce County Meat Animal Project (beef, goat, sheep or swine), have been in the Meat Animal Project for at least four years & have sold at least one animal on a Pierce County Livestock Auction.
- Applicants must bring a market animal tagged by the Pierce County Livestock Committee to 2024 Pierce County Fair.

Award winners will be announced at their schools awards program prior to graduation. Scholarship checks will be mailed to the scholarship winners at the completion of their first semester in the school they will be attending next fall. A copy of your transcript from the school, a certificate of completion or other Pierce County Livestock approved verification will need to be turned in to the Livestock Committee before payment can be sent. Transcripts must have a minimum 2.5 GPA to receive the award.
